

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(HARWELL, B4493) (2 METRES MAXIMUM WIDTH RESTRICTION) ORDER 20\*\***

The Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Harwell, B4493) (2 Metres Maximum Width Restriction) Order 20\*\* and shall come into force on the ..... day of ..... 20\*\*.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit a vehicle, the width of which inclusive of any load or apparatus on the vehicle exceeds 2 metres (6' 6") to proceed in any part of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle described therein to proceed in the lengths roads if the vehicle is being used:
  - (1) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (2) for access to or from any premises situated in or adjacent to the roads or accessible only from those roads;
  - (3) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (4) the vehicle is in the service of or employed by a Universal Service Provider and being used for the purpose of loading, unloading, delivering or collecting postal packets at premises or post boxes at or adjacent to that road;
  - (5) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water and electricity or telecommunications;
  - (6) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
4. The Oxfordshire County Council (Harwell) (Width Restriction) Order 1982 is hereby revoked.

## SCHEDULE

### Roads in the Parishes of Didcot and Harwell.

#### 1. In the Parish of Didcot

~~The B4493 Wantage Road from its junction with Slade Road to the Harwell parish boundary.~~

#### In the Parish of Harwell

- (a) B4493 Didcot Road including Burr Street, High Street and Wantage Road, ~~from the Didcot town boundary~~ **from a point 30 metres West of its roundabout junction with the (new) Harwell Link Road** to its junction with the A417 Reading Road.
- (b) Grove Road from its junction with B4493 High Street to its junction with the A4130 the Rowstock/Steventon road. ~~from its junction with the B4493 High Street~~ to its junction with the A4130 Rowstock/Steve nton road.
