NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

Notice is hereby given that Vale of White Horse District Council (the council) is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places within the Vale of White Horse.

The (Acting) Returning Officer for the parliamentary constituencies of Henley and Wantage will make comment on arrangements and those representations will be published on the council's website in accordance with the timetable set out below.

Electors within the Vale of White Horse, or the parliamentary constituencies of Oxford West and Abingdon, may make representation.

The council welcomes the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, or any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability, on the proposals and the (Acting) Returning Officer's representation or any other matter relating to the electoral process.

Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.

Any report published will have all personal data removed or anonymised. The data will be held until the next statutory polling place review in five years and then securely deleted
